An Act respecting the town of Victoriaville

WHEREAS the town of Victoriaville was authorized, by chapter 75 of the statutes of 1970, to pay an annual pension to the widows of two of its employees; whereas the town was authorized by chapter 96 of the statutes of 1982 to increase the amounts of the said pensions, and whereas it wishes to increase them again and to adjust them every year;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The town of Victoriaville may grant to Justine Bélair, during her lifetime, an annual pension of \$3 482.40 payable out of the general funds of the municipality, from 1 January 1991.

2. The town may grant to Germaine Châteauneuf, during her lifetime, an annual pension of \$2 872.98 payable out of the general funds of the municipality, from 1 January 1991.

3. Any pension payable under this Act shall be adjusted every year at the rate corresponding to the percentage of increase in the pension index determined by the Act respecting the Québec Pension Plan (R.S.Q., chapter R-9) which exceeds 3 per cent.
