EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to authorize the Government to pay out of the consolidated revenue fund the sum of \$236 881 875.00, being one-twelfth of the appropriations for the "Income Security" program of the Ministère de la Main-d'oeuvre, de la Sécurité du revenu et de la Formation professionnelle, and one-fourth of the appropriations for the "Income Security for Cree Hunters and Trappers" program of the same Department.

The sum will appear in the estimates of expenses of Québec for the fiscal year 1991-92.

Appropriation Act No. 1, 1991-92

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Government may take out of the consolidated revenue fund a sum not exceeding \$236 881 875.00 to defray a part of the expenses of Québec appearing in the budgetary estimates to be laid before the National Assembly for the fiscal year 1991-92 and not otherwise provided for.

That sum is apportioned as follows:

(1) \$233 066 525.00 being one-twelfth of the appropriations to be voted for Program 4 "Income Security", of the Ministère de la Main-d'oeuvre, de la Sécurité du revenu et de la Formation professionnelle;

(2) \$3 815 350.00 being one-fourth of the appropriations to be voted for Program 6, "Income Security for Cree Hunters and Trappers", of the Ministère de la Main-d'oeuvre, de la Sécurité du revenu et de la Formation professionnelle.
