EXPLANATORY NOTES

The purpose of this bill is to bring the Medical Act into harmony with the provisions of the Regulations Act and of the Professional Code with respect to the approval and coming into force of regulations and to establish uniformity between the period for appeal provided by the Medical Act and the period which applies generally under the Professional Code.

In addition, the bill establishes uniformity between the qualifications required of the directors of the Bureau of the Corporation professionnelle des médecins and those required under the Professional Code.

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Section 6 of the Medical Act (R.S.Q., chapter M-9) is amended by striking out the second paragraph.
- 2.** Section 20 of the said Act is amended by replacing the word “twenty” in the fifth line of the third paragraph by the word “thirty”.
- 3.** Section 22 of the said Act is amended by striking out the third paragraph.
- 4.** This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).
