**An Act to amend the Act respecting
the Régie des installations
olympiques**

QUOTIENT

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Act respecting the Régie des installations olympiques to allow the board to dispose of the Centre Paul-Sauvé. The bill also repeals the provisions of the Act respecting the Régie des installations olympiques which will cease to have effect upon the sale of the immovable.

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Régie des installations olympiques

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 13 of the Act respecting the Régie des installations olympiques (R.S.Q., chapter R-7) is amended

(1) by adding, at the end of the fourth paragraph, the following sentence: “The board may dispose of such installations in the manner determined by the Government.”;

(2) by striking out the fourth paragraph.

2. Section 16.1 of the said Act is repealed.

3. Section 17 of the said Act is amended by striking out the second paragraph.

4. Schedule A to this Act is repealed.

5. This Act will come into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*), except paragraph 2 of section 1 and sections 2 to 4 which will come into force on the date fixed by the Government.
