**An Act to amend the Act to amalgamate The General Trust of Canada
and the Administration and Trust Company**

WHEREAS General Trust of Canada has represented

that General Trust of Canada is a corporation incorporated as a trust company by chapter 80 of the statutes of 1970;

that the totality of its issued and paid-up common shares are held by General Trustco of Canada Inc.;

that the said shares are subject to restrictions as to the exercise of voting rights;

that it is expedient to free the said shares from such restrictions;

AND WHEREAS General Trust of Canada has requested that an Act be passed for that purpose, and it is expedient to grant the request;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 10 of The Charter of The General Trust of Canada (1970, chapter 80) is repealed.
