## **An Act to amend the Act respecting the Ross Sanatorium**

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the Ross Sanatorium Corporation that its charter, chapter 48 of the statutes of 1950-51, be amended;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** The title of the Act respecting the Ross Sanatorium (1950-51, chapter 48) is replaced by the following title: “An Act respecting the Corporation du centre hospitalier Mgr Ross”.

**2.** Section 1 of the said Act is amended

(1) by replacing the words “Ross Sanatorium Corporation” in the first paragraph by the words “Corporation du centre hospitalier Mgr Ross”;

(2) by inserting, after the second paragraph, the following paragraph:

“The object of the Corporation is to acquire, establish, possess, maintain, administer and manage a hospital centre and a reception centre within the meaning of the Act respecting health services and social services (R.S.Q., chapter S-5).”

**3.** Section 2 of the said Act is replaced by the following section:

**“2.** The Corporation shall be composed of not less than four nor more than ten members. The Director General and the Director of Professional Services of the establishment may be members of the Corporation. The other members shall be appointed by the Corporation in the manner prescribed in the by-laws.”

**4.** Section 4 of the said Act is amended by replacing paragraph *a* by the following paragraph:

“*a.* acquire, possess or lease movable or immovable property or hypothecate or alienate same;”

**5.** Sections 5, 6 and 8 of the said Act are repealed.

**6.** Section 9 of the said Act is amended by replacing the words “Ross Sanatorium Corporation” by the words “Corporation du centre hospitalier Mgr Ross”.

**7.** This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).
