An Act respecting the city of Rimouski

WHEREAS certain by-laws passed by the town council of Rimouski have not been published and whereas it is expedient to remedy this situation;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The by-laws passed by the town council of Rimouski before 1 June 1985 which have not been published according to law are deemed to be in effect and to have force of law as from the date on which they were passed or, as the case may be, as from the date of their final approval where they were submitted for one or more approvals.

2. No irregularity or illegality may be ascribed to the fact that such by-laws were not published in accordance with the law.

3. The clerk shall enter a reference to this Act in the record of the by-laws of the town council of Rimouski, opposite every registered by-law.
