**An Act respecting the municipality of
the township of Kénogami**

WHEREAS it is expedient to fix a general election date for the municipality of the township of Kénogami;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The election of the mayor and six councillors of the municipality of the township of Kénogami shall be held, for the year 1985, on the date fixed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

2. Articles 283 and 284 and the last paragraph of article 295 of the Municipal Code of Québec (R.S.Q., chapter C-27.1) apply, adapted as required, for the purposes of the election.

3. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).
