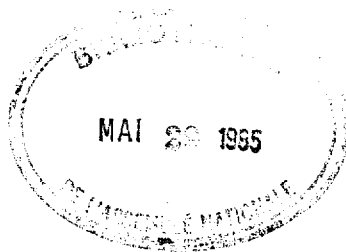

**An Act respecting the Richelieu Valley  
Waterworks Commission**

WHEREAS the municipalities that are members of the Comité Intermunicipal d'Aqueduc de la Vallée du Richelieu wish to have the resolutions, by-laws, contracts, engagements and deeds of the committee and of the Richelieu Valley Waterworks Commission made before the repeal of the Act creating the Commission, declared valid and incontestable;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** The resolutions, by-laws, contracts, engagements and deeds of the Comité Intermunicipal d'Aqueduc de la Vallée du Richelieu created on 28 June 1968 by Order TC-36 of the Régie des eaux du Québec are hereby declared valid and incontestable.

This section does not affect a case pending, a decision or a judgment rendered on 2 March 1985.

**2.** The resolutions, by-laws, contracts, engagements and deeds of the Richelieu Valley Waterworks Commission created under the Act respecting Richelieu Valley Waterworks Commission (1958-59, chapter 182) are hereby declared valid and incontestable.

No illegality or irregularity that may result from the failure of the Richelieu Valley Waterworks Commission to act in accordance with its incorporating Act may be set up against it owing to the fact that the resolutions, by-laws, contracts, engagements and deeds were made or passed by the Comité Intermunicipal d'Aqueduc de la Vallée du Richelieu.

This section does not affect a case pending, a decision or a judgment rendered on 2 March 1985.

**3.** The Act respecting Richelieu Valley Waterworks Commission — Commission d'Aqueduc de la Vallée du Richelieu (1958-59, chapter 182) is repealed.

**4.** This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B to the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

**5.** This Act shall come into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).
