## **Bill 240**

**(PRIVATE)**

An Act respecting Joseph-Gino Gagné

WHEREAS Joseph-Gino Gagné was born in Jonquière, on 11 June 1974, of the marriage of André Gagné and Lynda Genest, which was dissolved on 7 June 1977 by absolute judgment of divorce;

Whereas his mother, Lynda Genest, has been entrusted with his custody since then;

Whereas, since birth, he has been residing with his mother at his maternal grandfather's;

Whereas, owing to these circumstances, his familiars know him under the name of Gino Genest;

Whereas he must begin to attend school in September 1979 and it is in his interest, from a practical, affective and psychological point of view, that his name be the one under which he is known;

Therefore, Her Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The tutor of Joseph-Gino Gagné is authorized on the advice of the family council and with the authorization of the judge, to apply for the change of the name of Joseph-Gino Gagné, in conformity with the Act respecting the change of name and of other particulars of civil status (1965, 1st session, chapter 77).

**2.** This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
