



CHAPTER 7

An Act to ensure completion of the Montreal University building

[Assented to, the 9th of May, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Sections 19 and 20 of the Act to come to the assistance of Montreal University (3 George VI, chapter 69) are replaced by the following: 3 Geo. VI, c. 69, ss. 19, 20, replaced.

“**19.** During ten years counting from the coming into force of this act, the Government shall pay annually to the Society the sum of three hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars to assist it in meeting the cost of the instruction given in Montreal University and other incidental expenses.” Annual payments to Montreal University Administration Society for cost of instruction.

“**20.** In order to ensure the execution of the work contemplated in the first paragraph of section 22, a grant of two million five hundred thousand dollars is made to the Society. In addition, upon the transfer to the Minister of Public Works of the Society's immoveables situated on St. Denis street and on St. Hubert street, in Montreal, a sum of eight hundred thousand dollars shall be paid. The whole shall be paid to the Society in three equal annual instalments, the first of which shall be made during the fiscal year 1941-42. The complete description of the property to be acquired and the other conditions of the purchase and of the grants shall be determined by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.” Id., for execution of the work.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
