



## CHAPTER 16

An Act to amend the Act to provide for the consolidation of the laws of the Province

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1941]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Sections 2 and 3 of the Act to provide for the consolidation of the laws of the Province (1 George VI, chapter 12) are replaced by the following: 1 Geo. VI, c. 12, ss. 2, 3, replaced.

**“2.** They shall be charged with consolidating, Duties. excepting the codes, the laws of a general and permanent nature then in force, citing the authorities on which they base themselves and coördinating them anew, following the legislative technique.

Whenever a portion of the work is sufficiently advanced it shall be forwarded to the Attorney-General with a report.” Reports.

**“3.** The said persons may, in special reports, suggest such legislative changes as appear desirable to them, specifying the reasons therefor.” Suggestions authorized.

**2.** The act 3 George VI, chapter 6, is repealed. 3 Geo. VI, c. 6, repealed.

**3.** The provisions of this act shall have force as from the 1st of January, 1941. Retroactive effect.

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
