



CHAPTER 27

An Act respecting the canalization of the St. Lawrence

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1941]

WHEREAS an agreement has been entered into Preamble.
between the Government of Canada and the
Government of the United States for the canalization
of the St. Lawrence and the development in connection
therewith of its water-powers;

Whereas the Government of Canada has asked the
Government of this Province to determine, by mutual
agreement, the conditions of its participation in such
undertaking;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent
of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative
Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon Agreement authorized.
such conditions as he may determine in the best inter-
ests of the Province, authorize the Minister of Lands
and Forests to enter into an agreement with the Go-
vernment of Canada, with respect to the canalization
of the St. Lawrence and the development of its water-
powers.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force.
sanction.
