



CHAPTER 34

An Act to promote the cultivation of sugar beets

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon such conditions as he may deem fit to fix, authorize the Minister of Agriculture to purchase and re-sell all the machinery and equipment necessary for a beet-sugar factory. Purchase of machinery, etc., authorized for beet-sugar factory.

The sums required for such purchase shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund, up to a total of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars. Expenditure.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Agriculture to guarantee to the *compagnie de sucre de betterave Richelieu, Ltée*, the delivery at the plant it is to erect of at least one hundred thousand tons of sugar beets per year for five years, upon the conditions agreed upon between them; and to undertake, in default of delivery, to pay one dollar per ton not delivered. Guarantee of delivery of sugar beets, authorized.

The sums due under the agreement contemplated in this section shall be payable out of the consolidated revenue fund. Expenditure.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
