



CHAPTER 36

An Act to promote, by means of a premium, the development of peat-bogs

[Assented to, the 13th of March, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. This act may be cited as the *Peat Premium Act*. Short title.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized to pay annually, during a period of four years to be computed from the first of April, 1940, a premium on the marketable product of any peat-bog in which, in the course of the first two of such years, the extraction and placing on sale of peat are initiated. Premium for developing peat-bogs.

For such purpose, he may make any regulations respecting the amount of the premium to be granted, the information to be given and the conditions to be fulfilled in order to obtain the same. Regulations.

3. The expenditure incurred for the carrying out of this act must not exceed the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars for each of the said four years, and shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund of the Province. Expenditure.

4. The Minister of Mines shall have charge of the carrying out of this act. Carrying out of act.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
