



CHAPTER 40

An Act to authorize the construction of a bridge in the township of Dubuisson

[Assented to, the 13th of March, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Public Works to construct a bridge over the arm of Lake De Montigny which connects with Lake Lemoine, in the township of Dubuisson, in the county of Abitibi. Construction of bridge authorized.

2. The Minister of Public Works may acquire, by agreement or by expropriation, all the immoveables or servitudes which he may deem necessary for the construction of such bridge, of the roads giving access thereto and of other accessory works. Acquisitions by Minister.

3. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may devote to the construction of such bridge, roads giving access thereto and other accessory works, a sum not exceeding three hundred and fifty thousand dollars to be taken from the consolidated revenue fund. Appropriation of funds.

4. Such bridge shall be a public work for which tolls may be imposed, in accordance with Division VI of the Public Works Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 95). Tolls.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
