



CHAPTER 43

An Act to authorize municipal corporations to contribute toward the war effort

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Whatever may be the law which governs them, all the municipal corporations of the Province shall have the right to contribute unappropriated moneys out of their general funds toward the Country's war effort and, especially, to subscribe for all war work and to purchase war savings stamps or war savings certificates of the Government of Canada. Municipalities may contribute to war effort.
2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction and shall cease to have effect as from and after the date of a proclamation of the Governor General declaring that the present state of war has ceased. Coming into force, automatic repeal.
