



CHAPTER 57

An Act to amend the Partnership Declaration Act

[Assented to, the 9th of May, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 11 of the Partnership Declaration Act R.S., c. 224, s. 11, am. (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 224), as amended by the act 1 George VI, chapter 95, section 8, is again amended by replacing the words: "time when such style is first used", in the second line of subsection 2 thereof, by the words: "date when such style is first used, and shall mention such date."

2. Section 10 of the said act is repealed, and, in Id., s. 10, repealed and replaced by s. 13a. lieu thereof, the following subdivision and section are inserted after section 13 of the said act:

"§ 2a.—*Forbidden Declarations*

"**13a.** No declaration required by this division may be registered if a person or partnership assumes therein a name, style or firm name which designates an existing partnership or another person or which so resembles the same that the public may be led into error. Name similar to another cannot be registered.

Every registration made contrary to the provisions of this section may be annulled by the Superior Court of the district upon petition, after notice given to the interested parties and to the prothonotary. Annulling of registration.

3. Form 3 of the said act is amended by replacing the words: "carry on and that", in the fourth and fifth R. S., c. 224, form 3, am.
