



CHAPTER 60

An Act to amend the Collective Agreement Act

[Assented to, the 9th of May, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 10 of the Collective Agreement Act (4 Geo. VI, c. 38, s. 10, am.) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“The decree may render obligatory minimum prices to be charged to the public for the services of barbers and hairdressers.” Obligatory minimum prices.

2. Section 20 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following sub-paragraph:

“*l.* By regulation approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, grant to its members, in addition to their travelling expenses, fees not exceeding five dollars for each attendance; such remuneration not to be paid for more than one meeting per week.” Attendance fees.

3. Section 21 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“The committee must keep duplicates of such reports and show them to any person requesting same, during ordinary office hours.” Duplicates of reports.

4. Section 42 of the said act is amended by replacing the letter: “*d*”, in the fifth line thereof, by the letter: “*e*”. 4 Geo. VI, c. 38, s. 42, am.

5. Section 60 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph: Id., s. 60, am.

Appeal. “In the case of summary proceeding, an appeal shall lie when the fine provided for the offence is two hundred dollars or more.”

Coming into force. **6.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
