



CHAPTER 61

An Act to amend the Seigniorial Rent Abolition Act

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 26 of the Seigniorial Rent Abolition Act (25-26 George V, chapter 82), as amended by the act 4 George VI, chapter 25, section 4, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“The Board of Commissioners may, by resolution, order that any constituted rents affecting immoveables in the Province and included in terriers deposited under this act, shall be treated as constituted rents replacing seigniorial dues and be subject to all the provisions of this act. The cancelling of any registration relating to constituted rents so redeemed shall be effected upon the deposit, in the proper registration office, of a certificate from the secretary-treasurer of the Syndicate evidencing such redemption and describing the immoveables affected and the registrations to be cancelled. The Syndicate shall pay the registrar the fee fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.”

2. Section 32 of the said act is amended by replacing the words: “at any time”, in the first line thereof, by the words: “between the 11th and the 30th of November of every year”.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
