



CHAPTER 64

An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Act,
1931

[Assented to, the 29th of April, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative As-
sembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Workmen's Compensation Act, 1931, (21 21 Geo. V,
George V, chapter 100) is amended by adding thereto, c. 100, s. 9b,
after section 9a thereof, as enacted by the act 1 Edward added.
