



CHAPTER 64

An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Act,
1931

[Assented to, the 29th of April, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative As-
sembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Workmen's Compensation Act, 1931, (21 ^{21 Geo. V,} George V, chapter 100) is amended by adding thereto, ^{c. 100, s. 9b,} after section 9a thereof, as enacted by the act 1 Edward ^{added.} VIII (2nd Session) chapter 39, section 1, the following section:

"**9b.** No recourse contemplated in the two pre-
ceding sections may be exercised against the servants ^{No recourse}
or mandataries of the employer of the injured work- ^{in certain}
man by reason of any fault committed in the perform- ^{cases.}
ance of their duties."

2. Section 48 of the said act, as amended by the ^{21 Geo. V,} acts 23 George V, chapter 98, section 8, and I Edward ^{c. 100, s. 48} VIII (2nd Session), chapter 40, section 1, is again ^{am.} amended by replacing the word: "twelve", in the fifth line of subsection 2 thereof, by the word: "twenty-four".
