



CHAPTER 71

An Act for the embellishment of the city of Quebec

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1941]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. A body is hereby created, under the name of Quebec Embellishment Commission, charged with promoting the embellishing of the city of Quebec, the conserving of the distinctive character of the capital of the Province and all undertakings which may appear most desirable for such purposes. Quebec Embellishment Commission created.

2. The said Commission shall have its head office in the city of Quebec and shall be constituted as follows: Head office and constitution.

1. Of the mayor of the city of Quebec;
2. Of a person appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;
3. Of a person appointed by a resolution of the council of The Quebec Board of Trade (*La Chambre de Commerce de Québec*), during pleasure.

3. The Commission shall choose a chairman from amongst its members. Chairman.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council shall appoint the secretary of such Commission. The secretary shall call meetings by notice in writing given at least two days in advance. Secretary.

Two members shall form a quorum at the meetings. Decisions shall be made by the majority of the votes. Quorum, etc.

4. The members of the Commission shall not be entitled to any remuneration. Members not remunerated.

- Grant.** **5.** A sum of one hundred thousand dollars is granted for the expenses to be incurred for the purposes of the Commission during the present year and the years to come. Such sum shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund.
- Payment.** The said moneys, as well as any other amounts voted for the same purposes by the Legislature, shall be paid upon the order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council for such purposes and upon such conditions as he may deem expedient to fix.
- Admin. expenses, maximum.** The administrative expenses of the Commission paid out of the said sums shall not exceed two thousand dollars per annum.
- Coming into force.** **6.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
