



## CHAPTER 75

### An Act to amend the charter of the city of Trois-Rivières

*[Assented to, the 29th of April, 1941]*

**WHEREAS** the city of Trois-Rivières has, by its Preamble.  
petition, represented that the council, by selling to Dame Dorilda Deshaies, widow of Donat Gaudet, by a deed before J. Arthur Villeneuve, notary, dated the 9th of January, 1940, intended to free the purchaser from all taxes upon the immoveable mentioned therein, even from the consolidated taxes, but it was subsequently ascertained that the council could not transact for the consolidated taxes without being expressly authorized to do so by an act;

Whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer and also to ratify certain acts of its council;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The resolution of the council of the 20th of January, 1941, valuing certain property of City Gas & Electric Corporation Limited at twenty thousand dollars for five years in addition to the period mentioned in the act 1 George VI, chapter 106, section 16, which Resolution ratified. ratified for five years the resolution of the 29th of July, 1935, is confirmed and ratified.

2. The council of the city of Trois-Rivières is authorized to discharge the immoveable described in the deed of sale of the 9th of January, 1940, and contemplated by the resolution of the said council, dated the 3rd of February, 1941, from all taxes, even consolidated Authoriza-
