



CHAPTER 79

An Act to amend the charter of the town of Asbestos

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1941]

WHEREAS the town of Asbestos was incorporated Preamble.
as such by letters patent, on the 8th day of the
month of May, in the year nineteen hundred and
thirty-seven, and is governed by the provisions of the
Cities and Towns' Act of the Province of Quebec, and
the amendments made thereto by the act 2 George VI,
1938, chapter 115;

Whereas it is necessary for the proper administration
of the said town that section 173 of the said Cities and
Towns' Act be amended for the said town; and

Whereas the said town has presented a petition for
such purpose and it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent
of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative As-
sembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 173 of the Cities and Towns' Act (Re- R. S., c. 102,
vised Statutes, 1925, chapter 102), as amended by the s. 173,
act 23 George V, chapter 43, section 1, is replaced, replaced for
for the town of Asbestos, by the following: town.

“**173.** The election for mayor and aldermen shall Date of
be held on the first juridical day of February, in accor- elections.
dance with the provisions hereinafter contained.

Before the twentieth of January, 1942, three of the Election of
six seat-numbers shall be chosen at random by the half of the
person and in the manner determined by a resolution aldermen
of the council, and the aldermen whose seat-numbers each year.
have been so chosen shall go out of office; the election to
replace them shall be held on the first juridical day of
February, 1942; as for the mayor and the three re-
maining aldermen, their election shall be held on the

first juridical day of February, 1943; the whole in such manner that, thereafter, half the number of aldermen shall be renewed every year.

Change of
dates.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, by letters patent, upon the application of the council of the municipality concerned, change the date for the elections and the date for the nomination of candidates.

Procedure.

The proceedings and notices for such application shall, as far as possible, be the same as those required for obtaining letters patent under sections 12 and following of this act.

Notice.

Notice of such change must be published in the *Quebec Official Gazette* and in the volume of the Statutes passed at the then next session of the Legislature.”

Coming
into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
