



CHAPTER 84

An Act to ratify by-law number 37 of the corporation of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès and a resolution, dated the 3rd of December, 1940, of the school commissioners for the municipality of St. Etienne des Grès, in the county of St. Maurice

[Assented to, the 13th of March, 1941]

WHEREAS the corporation of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès, and the school commissioners for the municipality of St. Etienne des Grès, in the county of St. Maurice, have, by their petition, represented: that The Shawinigan Water & Power Company, a corporation having its chief place of business in the city and district of Montreal, is owner of a dam and hydro-electric plant situated in the river St. Maurice at the place called La Gabelle, part whereof is in the limits of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès; that it is in the interest of the corporation of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès and of the school commissioners for the municipality of St. Etienne des Grès, in the county of St. Maurice, to be assured for a period of ten years of the payment of municipal and school taxes and assessments based upon a fixed, uncontestable valuation; that, on the 4th of November, 1940, the council of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès unanimously adopted its by-law number 37, establishing and fixing the valuation of the whole of the taxable properties, held for hydro-electric development purposes by The Shawinigan Water & Power Company, at the sum of one million three hundred thousand dollars for a period of ten years; that the said by-law has been submitted for the approval of the electors who are property-owners in the said municipality and has been approved by the entire vote recorded; that, on the 3rd of December,

1940, the school commissioners for the municipality of St. Etienne des Grès, in the county of St. Maurice, unanimously adopted a resolution accepting for the same period the above-mentioned valuation to serve as the basis for the school assessments to be imposed during the same period by the said school commissioners;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition and to ratify the said by-law and the said resolution;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

By-law
ratified.

1. By-law number 37 of the corporation of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès, providing for a fixed valuation, during a period of ten years, of the whole of the taxable property held for hydro-electrical development by The Shawinigan Water & Power Company, is confirmed, ratified and declared obligatory for the corporation of the parish of St. Etienne des Grès, for the company mentioned in the said by-law, for its successors and assigns and for all the ratepayers concerned.

2. The said resolution of the school commissioners for the municipality of St. Etienne des Grès, in the county of St. Maurice, adopted on the 3rd of December, 1940, is confirmed, ratified and declared obligatory for the said school corporation, for the company mentioned in the said resolution, for its successors and assigns and for all the ratepayers concerned.
