



CHAPTER 91

An Act respecting *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie, de Montréal*

[Assented to, the 27th of March, 1941]

WHEREAS *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie, de Montréal* have, by their petition, represented: Preamble.

That they were incorporated by the act 7 George V, chapter 115;

That prior to the passing of the said act, they formed part of an already-existing religious corporation, namely: *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie*, incorporated by the act 61 Victoria, chapter 90, since amended by the act 2 George VI, chapter 131;

That the two corporations constitute, from a religious standpoint, but one and the same community and it is to their interest and expedient for the proper administration of their affairs that an act be passed declaring that the charter so obtained shall cease to be in force;

That the passing of this act is applied for with the consent of the said corporation, *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie*; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 7 George V, chapter 115, shall cease to be in force, and the corporation created under the name of *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie, de Montréal* is hereby declared dissolved and extinct. 7 Geo. V, c. 115, repealed.
Corporation dissolved.

Rights, etc.,
transferred.

2. The rights, privileges and property of the corporation mentioned in section 1 of this act are vested, subject to liability for its obligations, in *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie*, a corporation created by the act 61 Victoria, chapter 90, as amended by the act 2 George VI, chapter 131. The latter corporation shall benefit from any disposition of property made under the name of the extinct corporation.

Immoveables
transferred.

3. The immoveable property held by the dissolved corporation is specially declared to be the property of the corporation *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie*, which succeeds to it.

4. In order to give effect to section 3 of this act, a declaration, containing the description of the immoveable property and real rights belonging to the dissolved corporation, and citing the present act as a title of transmission to the corporation *Les Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie*, shall be filed with the registrar of the registration division in which each immoveable property or real right is situated.

Creditors'
recourse
affected.

5. The creditors of the dissolved corporation shall retain the same recourse against the property which belonged to it as they could have exercised before the passing of this act.

Coming
into force.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
