CHAPTER 1

An Act granting to His Majesty the moneys required for the expenses of the Government for the financial years ending on the 30th of June, 1940, and on the 31st of March, 1941, and for other purposes connected with the public service

[Assented to, the 22nd of June, 1940]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

WHEREOF it appears, by messages from Major-General the Honourable Sir Marie-Joseph-Eugène Fiset, Kt., C.M.G., D.S.O., M.D., Lieutenant-Governor of this Province, and the estimates accompanying the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Government of the Province, not otherwise provided for, for the financial years ending on the 30th of June, 1940, and on the 31st of March, 1941, and for other purposes connected with the public service; May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, that:

1. From and out of the consolidated revenue fund of this Province, there shall and may be taken a sum not exceeding, in the whole, four million, nine hundred and thirty-six thousand, twenty-six dollars and sixty-

nine cents, for defraying the charges and expenses of the Government and public service of this Province, for the financial year ending on the 30th of June, 1940, as set forth in Schedule A annexed to this act.

2. From and out of the consolidated revenue fund of this Province, a sum, not exceeding, in the whole, twenty-eight million, eight hundred and nine thousand, one hundred and nineteen dollars and ten cents, may be taken for defraying, during the financial year ending on the 31st of March, 1941, the charges and expenses of the Government and public service of the Province, as set forth in Schedule B annexed to this act.

3. Every payment or application of moneys, appropriated by this act, shall be held to be made provisionally, and subject to all adjustment in account hereinafter, in respect of the Dominion and of the Province of Ontario and of special funds which this act may in any manner affect.

4. Accounts, in detail, of all moneys expended under the authority of this act shall be laid before both Houses of the Legislature of the Province, in conformity with section 22 of the Provincial Audit Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 21).

5. The application of all sums expended under the authority of this act shall also be accounted for to His Majesty.
