



CHAPTER 26

An Act to amend the Coöperative Agricultural Association Act

[Assented to, the 14th of June, 1940]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 11 of the Coöperative Agricultural Association Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 57), as amended by the acts 20 George V, chapter 38, section 7, and 24 George V, chapter 26, section 1, is again amended by replacing the first paragraph thereof by the following:

“11. The association shall be managed by a board of ^{Directors,} five directors. Such number may be increased to seven ^{quorum, etc.} when the association consists of more than two hundred members, and to fifteen when it consists of more than five hundred. The majority of the directors shall constitute a quorum. The directors shall remain in office until the election of their successors at the annual general meeting. They shall be eligible for reëlection.”.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
