



CHAPTER 30

An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries Act

[Assented to, the 25th of April, 1940]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Quebec Fisheries Act (Revised R.S., c. 83, Statutes, 1925, chapter 83), amended by the acts 20^{s. 2, am.} George V, chapter 19, section 28; 25-26 George V, chapter 11, section 34, and 1 Edward VIII (2nd Session), chapter 20, section 13, is again amended:

- a. By striking out the words: "license" or", in the first line of paragraph 5 thereof;
- b. By repealing paragraph 6 thereof.

2. Section 3 of the said act is amended by replacing Id., s. 3, am. subsection 3 thereof by the following:

"3. However, for fishing in salmon rivers and in lakes, persons domiciled in the Province shall, before beginning to fish, even in waters in which the right to fish is private or is leased from the Crown, procure a special license from the Minister or from a person authorized by the Minister to grant one; persons not domiciled in the Province shall procure such a license before beginning to fish, whatever may be the place where they desire to fish.

The fee required shall be determined, in each case, by the Minister, but shall not exceed twenty-five dollars for persons not domiciled in the Province and one dollar and ten cents per annum for those domiciled therein."

3. Section 37 of the said act, as amended by the act 3 George VI, chapter 53, section 1, is again amended by inserting therein, after sub-paragraph *e* of sub-section 1 thereof, the following sub-paragraph:

Restrictions.

“*f.* Fixing the restrictions deemed necessary as to fishing in public lakes and water-courses stocked with fish by the Pisciculture Service of the Province.”.

4. Section 60 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the word: “superintendents”, in the second line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: “, fire-rangers, revenue and provincial police officers”.
