



CHAPTER 44

An Act to amend the Blind Persons Aid Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of June, 1940]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of the Blind Persons Aid Act (1 George VI, chapter 83) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs: 1 Geo. VI, c. 83, s. 3, am.

h. oblige the secretary-treasurer, treasurer or accountant of any municipality to supply, without charge, on the prescribed form, a certificate enumerating the immoveable properties which have been inscribed, in the name of any applicant, or in the name of such applicant's husband or wife, during the preceding five years, on the valuation roll of the municipality; Certificate supplied by secretary-treasurer, etc., without charge.

i. authorize the body charged with the carrying out of this act to supply annually to every municipality, a list of the persons benefiting from a pension in the Province or in any part of the Province; no communication may be given of such list except to the members and officers of the council of the municipality, who are forbidden to disclose the contents thereof; any officer of a municipality may indicate to the said body any person who does not appear to him to be entitled to a pension; List of pensioners supplied to municipalities. Contents thereof not to be disclosed. Indication of person not entitled to pension.

j. impose upon municipalities a contribution not exceeding 2% of the pensions paid to the pensioners domiciled therein; determine how the domicile shall be established for the purposes of such contribution, and regulate all the conditions thereof." Contribution by municipalities.

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force upon such date as the Lieutenant-Governor may be pleased to fix by proclamation.
