



## CHAPTER 44

### An Act to amend the Blind Persons Aid Act

*[Assented to, the 22nd of June, 1940]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative As-  
sembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 3 of the Blind Persons Aid Act (1 George VI, chapter 83) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs:

*h.* oblige the secretary-treasurer, treasurer or ac-  
countant of any municipality to supply, without charge,  
on the prescribed form, a certificate enumerating the  
immoveable properties which have been inscribed, in  
the name of any applicant, or in the name of such  
applicant's husband or wife, during the preceding five  
years, on the valuation roll of the municipality;

*i.* authorize the body charged with the carrying  
out of this act to supply annually to every municipality,  
a list of the persons benefiting from a pension in the  
Province or in any part of the Province; no communica-  
tion may be given of such list except to the members  
and officers of the council of the municipality, who are  
forbidden to disclose the contents thereof; any officer  
of a municipality may indicate to the said body any  
person who does not appear to him to be entitled to a  
pension;

*j.* impose upon municipalities a contribution not  
exceeding 2% of the pensions paid to the pensioners  
domiciled therein; determine how the domicile shall  
be established for the purposes of such contribution,  
and regulate all the conditions thereof."

Coming into  
force.

**2.** This act shall come into force upon such date as the Lieutenant-Governor may be pleased to fix by proclamation.
