



## CHAPTER 92

An Act to ratify the resolution adopted on the 29th of January, 1940, by the school commissioners of the town of La Tuque

*[Assented to, the 30th of May, 1940]*

**WHEREAS** the school commission of the town of Preamble.

La Tuque has, by its petition, represented that it is expedient, in the interest of the ratepayers and for the good administration of the affairs of the school commission of the town of La Tuque, to ratify the resolution passed by the school commissioners of the said school municipality, on the 29th of January, 1940, which resolution provides:

a. For the fixing, for a period of ten years, from the first of July, 1940, up to the first of July 1950, at the sum of four million dollars, the taxable immoveable properties of the Brown Corporation or its assigns, situated within the town of La Tuque, and utilized for industrial purposes, including the "Community Club" and the "Nurses' Home", the said Brown Corporation or its assigns to pay the real estate taxes on the said valuation of four million dollars during the said period of ten years, according to the rate fixed each year by resolution, in conformity with the law;

b. For the residential property and the immoveables not used for industrial purposes that the company possesses, shall build or shall acquire within the town of La Tuque, to be carried individually on the valuation roll and to be subject to the provisions of the law, like the other immoveables of the same kind, in the town of La Tuque, during the said period of ten years;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The resolution passed by the school commissioners of the town of La Tuque, on the 29th of January, 1940, providing: *a.* for the fixing, for a period of ten years, from the first of July, 1940, up to the first of July, 1950, at the sum of four million dollars, the valuation of the taxable immoveable properties of the Brown Corporation or its assigns, situated within the town of La Tuque, and utilized for industrial purposes, including the "Community Club" and the "Nurses' Home", the said Brown Corporation or its assigns to pay the real estate taxes on the said valuation of four million dollars during the said period of ten years, according to the rate fixed each year by resolution, in conformity with the law; *b.* for the residential property and the immoveables not used for industrial purposes that the company possesses, shall build or shall acquire within the town of La Tuque, to be carried individually on the valuation roll and to be subject to the provisions of the law, like the other immoveables of the same kind, in the town of La Tuque, during the said period of ten years,—is ratified and confirmed and declared valid, legal and binding, for all legal purposes, and it shall form part of this act.
