



CHAPTER 97

An Act to reestablish the limits of the Town of Noranda

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1940]

WHEREAS the town of Noranda has, by its *Preamble.* petition, represented that it was erected into a town municipality by the act 16 George V, chapter 79;

That the limits of the town of Noranda were fixed by section 2 of the said act;

That the town of Rouyn was erected into a town municipality by the act 17 George V, chapter 89;

That the limits of the town of Rouyn were fixed by section 3 of the said act 17 George V, chapter 89;

That the town of Rouyn, without giving notice to the council of the town of Noranda and without publishing in the *Quebec Official Gazette* the ordinary preliminary notices, asked the Legislature, at the session of 1939, to change the limits of the town of Rouyn so as to include a part of the territory of the town of Noranda;

That it did not appear in the petition nor in the private Bill No. 155 of the session of 1939, respecting the amending of the charter of the town of Rouyn, that the passing by the Legislature of the Bill of the town of Rouyn would have for effect the changing of the limits of the town of Noranda;

That it in nowise appears in the reading of section 1 of the act 3 George VI, chapter 122, that the said act, intituled: "An act to amend the charter of the town of Rouyn", has for object the changing of the limits of the town of Noranda;

That only accidentally and a long time after the sanctioning of the said act 3 George VI, chapter 122,

the town of Noranda was informed that an act to amend the charter of the town of Rouyn had the effect of amending the charter of the town of Noranda by taking from it a part of its territory;

That the council of the town of Noranda did not have the opportunity of submitting to the Legislature its objections to such a change in its limits;

That it is in the interest of the ratepayers of the town of Noranda to retain the territory which was detached from it by section 1 of the act 3 George VI, chapter 122, with a view to the execution of the general plan of the town of Noranda and to permit its full development;

That it is expedient to reestablish the limits of the town of Noranda as they were established by the act 16 George V, chapter 79, sanctioned on the 11th of March, 1929;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of the act 17 George V, chapter 89, as replaced by the act 3 George VI, chapter 122, section 1, is again replaced by the following:

“3. The territory of the town of Rouyn shall comprise in the township of Rouyn—in reference to the original subdivision of said township—the following lots of land, to wit:

- a. The whole of the mining block forty-one (41);
- b. The whole of the mining block eight (8);
- c. The territory known and designated under the name of Rouyn-South.”.

Coming into

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
