



CHAPTER 100

An Act to amend the charter of the town of Amos

[Assented to, the 22nd of June, 1940]

WHEREAS the corporation of the town of Amos has, Preamble.
by its petition, represented that it is governed by the Cities and Towns' Act and also by the provisions of its charter, the acts 15 George V, chapter 103, and 22 George V, chapter 115;

That by its by-law No. 169, adopted by its council on the 6th of February, 1940, and unanimously approved by the elector-proprietors the 29th of February and 1st of March, 1940, it was authorized to build a waterworks system and to borrow an amount of two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars to pay the cost thereof;

That the said by-law No. 169 has been approved by the Quebec Municipal Commission;

That such by-law also provides for the creation of a "Public Utility Commission of the Town of Amos", to assume the administration of the waterworks to be built and also of any other public utility system which the town of Amos may acquire, build or operate in the future;

That it wishes to be authorized to utilize any amount available from the loan of two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars decreed by by-law No. 169, for the purchase of all or part of the waterworks system now supplying the town of Amos, if it deems it advisable in the interest of its ratepayers to do so;

That it prays for the passing of an act for the purpose of ratifying its by-law No. 169 and for the other purposes abovementioned;

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

By-law ratified, etc.

1. By-law No. 169 of the town of Amos decreeing the construction of a waterworks system and a loan of two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars to pay the cost thereof, and also the creation of a "Public Utility Commission of the Town of Amos" to assume the administration of the said waterworks system, is confirmed, declared valid and ratified, for all legal purposes, except the paragraph 9 thereof, which is struck out.

Public Utility Commission of the town of Amos.

2. The "Public Utility Commission of the Town of Amos", created by By-law No. 169, shall assume the administration of all new public utilities which the town of Amos may build, acquire or operate in the future.

Monies that may be used for purchase of waterworks.

3. The council of the town of Amos is authorized to make use, for the purchase of all or part of the existing waterworks system now supplying the town of Amos, of any amount available from the loan of two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars decreed by by-law No. 169, if the council decides that it is in the interest of the ratepayers to do so.

Use of monies decreed by resolution, etc.

The use of such amount shall be decreed by a resolution which shall come into force only after having been approved by the Quebec Municipal Commission.

Coming into force of by-law No. 169.

4. By-law No. 169 of the council of the town of Amos shall come into force on the date of its approval by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Coming into force.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
