



CHAPTER 109

An Act to ratify a resolution of the corporation of the parish of St. Féréol, county of Montmorency, and a contract concerning the said corporation and the Quebec Power Company

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1940]

WHEREAS the corporation of the parish of St. Féréol, a body politic and corporate having its principal place of business at St. Féréol, has, by its petition, represented: Preamble.

That on the 2nd day of October, 1939, it adopted a resolution authorizing the passing of a contract to fix the municipal valuation of the taxable properties of the Quebec Power Company, for a period of twenty years, as well as a special yearly contribution;

That the said resolution was adopted after negotiations between the mayor and councillors of the said corporation and the company, to end a series of lawsuits between the parties;

That after the said resolution, a contract was entered into between the municipality and the company giving effect to the said resolution;

That the said resolution and contract cannot be valid before their ratification and confirmation by the Legislature;

And whereas it is expedient to grant said prayer, restricting however to ten years the duration of the said resolution and contract;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**Resolution
ratified.**

1. The resolution adopted by the corporation of the parish of St. Féréol, county of Montmorency, dated 2nd of October, 1939, is confirmed and ratified for all legal purposes.

**Contract
ratified.**

2. The contract entered into on January 31st, 1940, between the corporation and the company, is confirmed and ratified for all legal purposes, and declared binding on the parties, their representatives and assigns, as well as on all the ratepayers of the said corporation.

Limitation.

3. The period during which the said resolution and contract shall be in force is reduced to ten years.

**Coming into
force.**

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
