



## CHAPTER 143

An Act to permit Marie Ernestine Frappier to change her name to Ernestine Beaudry

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1940]

WHEREAS Marie Ernestine Frappier of the city <sup>Preamble.</sup> of Montreal has, by her petition, represented :

That she is the daughter of Fabien Frappier and Julie Richard, both of whom died several years ago;

That she was born and christened at *Ile du Grand Calumet* in the county of Pontiac;

That, at the age of ten years, she came to live in Montreal, where she assumed the name of Ernestine Beaudry, and under such name has since been known;

That she always earned her living under that name, acquired possessions, bought properties, took out insurance policies and transacted all her business under the name of Ernestine Beaudry;

That she is not known under the name of Frappier;

Whereas the said Marie Ernestine Frappier desires to change her name to that of Ernestine Beaudry, and to have ratified for all purposes the acts, deeds, contracts or covenants, insurance policies and receipts, hitherto made and entered into by her under the name of Ernestine Beaudry, and

Whereas she has prayed that an act be passed for the said purpose; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant her prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The said Marie Ernestine Frappier shall in future be known and designated under the name of Ernestine Beaudry and, under the latter name, she shall be entitled to claim, exercise and possess all advantages, benefits, rights and titles that, without said change of name, she would have had the right to claim, exercise or possess; and all acts, deeds, contracts, covenants and insurance policies made, passed or obtained by her under the name of Ernestine Beaudry shall benefit her, bind her, and be considered as having been made, entered into and obtained by and under said name, for all purposes; and all legacies or gifts contained in wills or donations made in her favour under the name of Ernestine Beaudry shall benefit her; and, under the latter name, she may recover, hold and possess and be capable of inheriting moveable and immoveable properties and rights of any kind whatsoever that she may actually have, hold or possess, or that she may inherit in the future, or that she may recover, hold or possess, as fully and entirely as if the change of name had not been made by this act; the whole without prejudice to succession duties payable to the Province of Quebec as if this act had not been passed.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
