



CHAPTER 4

An Act respecting the expenditure incurred by the
Government for unemployment works

[Assented to, the 30th of March, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The expenditure incurred by the Government of the Province to pay the cost of works intended to aid the unemployed shall constitute capital expenditure.

2. When such expenditure is paid out of the consolidated revenue fund, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Provincial Treasurer to borrow, in such manner, for such period, at such rates of interest and for such amounts as he may determine, the sums required to reimburse such expenditure, in whole or in part, to the consolidated revenue fund.

3. Such expenditure and the value of such works, to the extent of the amounts paid by the Government, shall not be taken into account, for loan purposes, in the assets of the municipal corporations, as long as the loans contemplated in section 2 or contracted to pay the cost of such works have not been reimbursed.

4. The provisions of sections 1 and 2 shall be in effect as from the 1st of September, 1936.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
