



## CHAPTER 10

An Act to annex the Municipality of Fermont to the parish of Saint Maurice, in the county of Champlain

[Assented to, the 30th of March, 1939]

**W**HEREAS by the act 22 Victoria, chapter 109, the Preamble.  
village then known by the name of Radnor Forges  
was incorporated under the name of Municipality of Fer-  
mont;

Whereas such territory has not, for several years, been within the conditions prescribed by the Municipal Code to continue to form a distinct municipality and, in fact, no municipal organization exists there any longer;

Whereas such territory had been detached from the municipality of the parish of Saint Maurice, and

Whereas, in consequence, it should be annexed to the said municipality;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The lands known and designated by the numbers one to sixty-nine inclusively of the official cadastre made for the village of Fermont, in the registration division of Champlain, which are taken from the original lots numbers eighteen, nineteen and twenty of the North-West concession of the range of Sainte-Marguerite, and twenty, twenty-one and twenty-two of the South-East concession of the range of Sainte-Marguerite, in the Seigniorship of Cap de la Madeleine, are hereby annexed to the municipality of the parish of Saint Maurice, in the county of Champlain. Annexation of the municipality of Fermont to the parish of Saint-Maurice.

**2.** The act 22 Victoria, chapter 109, is repealed.
