



CHAPTER 28

An Act respecting certain vacant property without an owner

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The following are deemed to be vacant property and without an owner, belonging to His Majesty in the rights of the Province of Quebec, deposits of money and of securities and all credits in specie or in securities, with the fruits thereof, in credit institutions and all other establishments which receive funds or securities on deposit, whenever, for thirty years or more, such deposits or credits have not been the subject of any operation or claim by the persons entitled thereto.

Several claims may be joined in the same demand for the recovery of such property from one and the same deposi-
sitary.

Joining of
claims.

2. The property contemplated in section 1 shall be subject to the application of sections 2 to 5, inclusively, of Chapter 49 of the Revised Statutes, 1925.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc-
tion.
