



## CHAPTER 33

An Act to aid in the sale of agricultural products

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture, take such measures as he may deem appropriate, within the limits of the constitutional rights of the Province, to promote the improvement of the growing, distributing and marketing of agricultural products and in general of the natural products of the Province. Measures to promote improvement of growing, etc., of agricultural products.

**2.** He may, for such purposes, and within the limits of his jurisdiction, Powers in that respect.

*a.* Collaborate and enter into agreement with any person, partnership, corporation, institution, government or governmental body;

*b.* Secure for the Province, by every means which he may deem suitable, the advantages of a marketing organization for farm products and the other natural products of the Province;

*c.* Form, for the pursuit of such objects, a provincial council for organizing the natural products' market,

charged, under the direction of the Minister of Agriculture, to coöperate with any similar body of the federal authority and in general to collaborate in the carrying out of this act;

*d.* Determine the structure, powers and duties of such council.

Expenditure. **3.** The expenditure occasioned by the carrying out of this act shall be payable out of the consolidated revenue fund.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
