



CHAPTER 35

An Act respecting the agricultural teaching of young orphans

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

WHEREAS, under the direction of the religious corporation of the *Frères de Notre-Dame de la Miséricorde*, an agricultural school has been established at Lake Sergent, to prepare orphans, who are without resources, for agriculture and colonization and, for such purposes, to give them a solid vocational training; Preamble.

Whereas it is in the Province's interest to contribute to this eminently national work;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture, is authorized to enter into, upon such conditions as he may determine, with the religious corporation of the *Frères de Notre-Dame de la Miséricorde*, an agreement with a view to the establishing and maintaining, at Lake Sergent, of an agricultural orphanage intended to train for agriculture and colonization, by means of suitable theoretical and practical instruction, the orphans who are without resources and whom this religious corporation gathers in Province, and to pay for such purpose to the said corporation, out of the consolidated revenue fund, during a period of ten years, an annual subsidy of six thousand dollars. Entering into certain agreement authorized.

2. This act shall be in effect as from the 1st of September, 1938. Retroactivity.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
