



CHAPTER 49

An Act to encourage the progress of colonization and of agriculture and the conservation of the forest domain

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Colonization, the Minister of Agriculture and the Minister of Lands and Forests, enter into with the Government of Canada any covenant or agreement of a nature to encourage the establishing of settlers, the back to the land movement, the progress of agriculture and the conservation of the forest domain. Entering into certain agreement, etc., authorized.

2. The Government of the Province is authorized to take all such measures as it may deem necessary for the carrying out of this act and the executing of the covenants or agreements entered into under the authority of section 1. Carrying out of act., etc.

3. The expenditure occasioned through the carrying out of this act shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund. Expenditure.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
