



## CHAPTER 57

An Act to amend the Mount Orford National Park Act

[Assented to, the 16th of March, 1939]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Council of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 4 of the Mount Orford National Park Act <sup>2 Geo. VI, c. 49, s. 4, am.</sup> (2 George VI, chapter 49) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs:

“The Government of the Province may, however, <sup>ac-</sup>Acquiring of certain prop-  
quire, by mutual agreement or by expropriation, any land <sup>erty.</sup>erty.  
situated within the park or any right or interest affecting  
such land.

It may also, upon the recommendation of the Minister <sup>Exchange</sup>Exchange  
of Mines and Fisheries and of the Minister of Lands and <sup>of property.</sup>of property.  
Forests, give property of the public domain in exchange for  
such land, right or interest.”

**2.** Section 10 of the said act is amended by replacing <sup>2 Geo VI, c. 49, s. 10, am.</sup>2 Geo VI, c. 49, s. 10, am.  
sub-paragraph *f* thereof by the following:

“*f.* The issuing and the price of licenses and permits, the <sup>Issuing, etc.,</sup>Issuing, etc.,  
leasing of grounds for the laying out and operating of golf, <sup>of licenses,</sup>of licenses,  
tennis, skiing or other games, and the leasing of club houses, <sup>etc</sup>etc  
restaurants, rest-houses, or other necessary buildings;”.
