



CHAPTER 75

An Act to aid in the rebuilding of Stanstead College

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of any general law or special act, the municipal councils of the village of Stanstead Plain, the village of Rock Island, and the municipality of the township of Stanstead, and the Protestant school commissioners of the township of Stanstead, the village of Stanstead Plain, and the village of Rock Island may, as the case may be, by resolution and without any approval other than that of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Trade and Commerce and the Quebec Municipal Commission (and/or the secretary of Education), subscribe for and pay, out of their general funds, contributions to aid in the rebuilding of Stanstead College, burned down in May, 1938.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
