



CHAPTER 78

An Act respecting the Juvenile Delinquents' Court of Montreal

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 254 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised R.S., c. 145,
Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto ^{s. 254, am.}
the following paragraph:

“He may also appoint, in the same manner, another <sup>Appointing of
certain judge.</sup>
judge of the said court, who shall exercise the same powers
and the same jurisdiction as the judge mentioned in the
preceding paragraph.”

2. Section 255 of the said act, as amended by the act R.S., c. 145,
22 George V, chapter 64, section 1, is again amended by ^{s. 255, am.}
replacing the words: “the judge”, in the first line thereof,
by the words: “each of the judges”.

3. Section 256 of the said act is amended by replacing ^{Id., s. 256,}
the words: “the judge”, in the first line thereof, by the ^{am.}
words: “every judge”.

4. Section 257 of the said act is amended by replacing ^{Id., s. 257,}
the word: “the”, in the first line thereof, by the word: ^{am.}
“any”.

5. Section 258 of the said act is amended by replacing ^{Id., s. 258,}
the words: “The judge”, in the first line thereof, by the ^{am.}
words: “Every judge”.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into
force.</sup>
sanction.
