



## CHAPTER 78

### An Act respecting the Juvenile Delinquents' Court of Montreal

*[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 254 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised R.S., c. 145,  
Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto <sup>s. 254, am.</sup>  
the following paragraph:

"He may also appoint, in the same manner, another <sup>Appointing of  
certain judge.</sup>  
judge of the said court, who shall exercise the same powers  
and the same jurisdiction as the judge mentioned in the  
preceding paragraph."

**2.** Section 255 of the said act, as amended by the act R.S., c. 145,  
22 George V, chapter 64, section 1, is again amended by <sup>s. 255, am.</sup>  
replacing the words: "the judge", in the first line thereof,  
by the words: "each of the judges".

**3.** Section 256 of the said act is amended by replacing <sup>Id., s. 256,</sup>  
the words: "the judge", in the first line thereof, by the <sup>am.</sup>  
words: "every judge".

**4.** Section 257 of the said act is amended by replacing <sup>Id., s. 257,</sup>  
the word: "the", in the first line thereof, by the word: <sup>am.</sup>  
"any".

**5.** Section 258 of the said act is amended by replacing <sup>Id., s. 258,</sup>  
the words: "The judge", in the first line thereof, by the <sup>am.</sup>  
words: "Every judge".

**6.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into  
force.</sup>  
sanction.
