



CHAPTER 80

An Act to amend the Electricians' and Electrical Installation Act

[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 8 of the Electricians' and Electrical Installation Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 178, as enacted by the act 18 George V, chapter 62, section 1), as replaced by the act 23 George V, chapter 70, section 10, is amended by inserting therein, after the word: "inspection", in the fifth line thereof, the words: "and approval of the plans contemplated in section 3". R.S., c. 178, s. 8, am.

2. Section 28 of the said act, as amended by the act 23 George V, section 70, section 21, is repealed. Id., s. 28, repealed.

3. Section 34 of the said act, as amended by the act 23 George V, chapter 70, section 23, is again amended by inserting therein, after the word: "exigible", in sub-paragraph *a* of paragraph 2 thereof, the words: " , under reserve, however, of the recourse contemplated by section 39*a*, which may be exercised independently of the prosecution for infringement of this sub-paragraph". 4. The said act is amended by adding thereto, after section 39 thereof, the following section: Id., s. 39*a*, added.

"39*a*. The fees exigible in virtue of this act may be claimed, by ordinary suit in the name of His Majesty the King, before any tribunal of competent civil jurisdiction, without prejudice to the prosecution for infringement of sub-paragraph *a* of paragraph 2 of section 34." Claiming of fees.

5. Section 40 of the said act is amended by replacing the words: "under this act", in the first line of subsection 1 thereof, by the words: "for violation of this act or of the regulations".
