



## CHAPTER 81

### An Act to amend the Quebec Public Health Act

*[Assented to, the 28th of April, 1939]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Sections 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of the Quebec R.S., c. 186, Public Health Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 186), <sup>ss. 14, 15, 16,</sup> as amended by the acts 16 George V, chapter 14; 16 George V, chapter 54; 18 George V, chapter 68; 19 George V, chapter 59; 20 George V, chapter 44; 20 George V, chapter 45; 21 George V, chapter 78; 23 George V, chapter 73; 24 George V, chapter 58, and 1 George VI, chapter 61, are repealed.

**2.** Section 20 of the said act, as amended by the act *Id.*, s. 20, am. 18 George V, chapter 68, section 4, is again amended:

*a.* By striking out the words: "given after consulting the Board of Health", in the second and third lines of the first paragraph thereof;

*b.* By adding thereto, after paragraph 5 thereof, the following paragraphs:

"6. To assure the sanitary condition of beaches, swimming pools, country resorts and tourists' camps;

"7. To prevent and check contagious diseases, especially venereal diseases;

"8. To provide for special and urgent measures, whenever the Province or a part of the Province seems to be threatened by any epidemic, endemic or contagious disease;"

c. By replacing the figures: "6, 7, 8 and 9", in the first line of paragraphs 6, 7, 8 and 9, by the figures: "9, 10, 11 and 12", respectively.

**3.** Section 99 of the said act, as amended by the act 18 George V, chapter 68, section 11, is again amended by striking out the words: "and after consultation of the Board of Health", in the second and third lines of subsection 1 thereof.
