



CHAPTER 83

An Act to amend the Blind Persons Aid Act respecting the registration of the notice of pension

[Assented to, the 30th of March, 1939]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Blind Persons Aid Act (1 George VI, chapter 83) ^{1 Geo. VI, c. 83, s. 7a, added.} is amended by adding thereto, after section 7 thereof, the following section:

“**7a.** When the grantee of a pension is owner of an ^{Registering of notice of pension.} immovable or of a real right registered against an immovable, a notice of the pension granted may be registered thereon.

Such notice shall be given over the signature of any ^{How notice given.} person authorized for such purpose by the body or the Minister entrusted with the administration of this act and must contain the following information:

- a.* The Christian names, surname and residence of the ^{Contents of notice.} pensioner;
- b.* The date on which such pension was granted to him;
- c.* A description of the immovable.

After the registration of such notice, the registrar shall ^{Effect of registration.} not register against the immovable any deed of hypothec, privilege, transfer, sale, assignment or otherwise, creating any charge whatsoever upon the said immovable, save with a consent in writing signed by a person authorized as aforesaid.

The registration of the notice is cancelled upon produc- ^{Cancellation.} tion of a certificate bearing the signature of a person duly authorized for such purpose.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into force.} sanction.
